### Art in Society

This course examines art from the fifteenth through the twentieth centuries. Some course-related activities include study at the Prado, Reina Sofia, Pergamon, Bode, Louvre, D'Orsay, Uffizi and La Accademia Museums.

### International Business

An overview of the environment in which international businesses compete. Some course-related activities include seminars at the offices of El Corte Ingles (Retail), Renfe (Railroad), Autostadt (Volkswagen Plant) (Wolfsburg), Fragonard (Perfume), Prada (Fashion), Ducati (Motorcycles) and Estrella Damm (Beer).

### Intercultural Communications
